Cellulars

Mobile phones must be turned off.

If a cell-phone makes any sound during the game, this game will be declared lost for the cell-phone owner.

Recording of the Moves

Recording of the moves is mandatory in the Open group and U-18 group. In the U-12 group, the players may record their moves, but this is optional.

Games in the Open and U-18 Group are valid for the official FIDE rating.
